

Notice of Election for a Member of the Electoral Division of **COROZAL SOUTH EAST**.

His Excellency the Governor-General, having issued his writ for the election of a member of the House of Representatives for the electoral division of **COROZAL SOUTH EAST**. The Returning Officer of the said division will proceed to the nomination of candidates on **Friday, the 16th day of October, 2015** between the hours of **10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.** at the **Roman Catholic School, San Joaquin, Corozal District**.

Every nomination paper must be signed by **six persons (6)** whose names appear on the register of electors and be handed to the Returning Officer between the said hours of **10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.**

Forms of nomination papers may be obtained at the **Elections and Boundaries Department Office, 1st Street North, Corozal Town**, between the hours of **8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.** daily **Monday to Friday**.

Every candidate for election shall deposit, or cause to be deposited, with the Returning Officer the sum of **two hundred dollars (\$200.00)**, as required by Rule 6 of the Election Rules.

In the event of the election being contested, the poll will take place between the hours of **7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.** on **WEDNESDAY, 4TH NOVEMBER, 2015**, and the counting of votes will take place thereafter at the **Roman Catholic School, San Joaquin Village, Corozal District**, on the said **4th November, 2015** at the hour of 8:00 p.m. and at such places as may hereafter be appointed.

The Returning Officer for the electoral division of **COROZAL SOUTH EAST** is **Ms. Debra Baptist Estrada** whose office is situated at the **Immigration Department, Corozal District**.
